Dear REACH Homeschool Families,

It is with great anticipation that we present you with the Spring 2011 Co-Op information packet. This semester's co-op is boldly going where no co-op has gone before!

To start, Co-Op will begin on **March 17, 2011** with a parents orientation meeting at **8:45am** at Daniels Bible Church. The semester will run consecutively for **six weeks** and conclude on **April 21**. Please notice that we have changed our co-op time to run 8:50am-12:15pm. Plan to **arrive at 8:50am** so that our students can be dismissed and in class ready to learn **at 9am**.

The individual class times have also been extended to one hour each for Kindergarten through 3rd grade. For 4th grade and over, there will be **2 classes lasting for an hour and a half** each.

This semester the 4th graders and over will be **dissecting a cow's eye** in Science Lab. We understand that some children may not be comfortable in participating in the actual dissection. If that is the case with your student, **they may pair up with a partner and just observe**. If your child **absolutely cannot handle being present during the dissection there will be an alternative lesson provided**. Please use the additional information area on the registration form to let us know if your child prefers a partner or an alternate lesson plan.

Additionally, the fees for co-op will not exceed \$50 per family. If your family cannot afford this amount there are supplementary funds available through REACH for which one can apply (application included in this packet).

Spring 2011 Co-op

Co-op will meet on **Thursdays from 8:50-12:15**, for 6 weeks from March 17, 2011 at **Daniels Bible Church** in Daniels. Please arrive at 8:45AM on March 17th for a Parents Meeting.

The following classes will be offered (schedule to be determined based on enrollment):

Nursery- Ages 2 years and under.

Preschool . Taught by Theresa Dennison

For children 3-4 years old. Snack will be scheduled to be provided by parents of children in this class. Pre-K will include 40 minutes of playtime to be planned and administered by the scheduled classroom helper. Theresa will be covering Emotions.

K-3rd

Kinderskills- Taught by Gina Smith

(Based on enrollment this class will substitute for Let's do some Art for our K students) Kinderskills is for our Kindergarten students only (must be 5 before 10/1/2010). Gina has an Arnold Lobel book planned each week with corresponding crafts to strengthen our classroom skills and have some fun too.

China- Taught by Stephanie Williams (K and up)

Your child will learn about the geography, history and culture of China.

Benjamin Franklin- Taught by Peggy Beth Lafferty

The children will learn Ben's role as a Founding Father, about his inventions, and discoveries.

Let's do some Art!- Taught by Amanda Moore

The kids will get to sample different art mediums, practice the techniques, and take home the art kit when the semester is complete. The proposed mediums are chalk, oil pastel, watercolor, charcoal, marker, and drawing pencil.

4th-Over

In order to allow our students to study more in-depth, we are offering two classes at 1.5 hour each.

WV History- Taught by Kim Beckett using the Abeka My State Notebook as a basic guide to learning WV state history and geography as well as beginning research skills.

Science with Lab- This science course will entail a general middle school overview focusing on the scientific method and basic laboratory experimentation. The learner will use the scientific method to create a project. Additionally, your student will be dissecting a cow's eyeball during the lab!
